General Needs for Kempton Park

- **Cleaning Supplies – A clean space creates a healing space!**
dishwashing liquid, auto washing powder, pine gel, bleach, heavy duty black bags
- **Toiletry Packs– Hygiene is dignity.**
Toothpaste, toothbrushes, shampoo, soap, deodorant, razor blades, lotion or Vaseline, towels, Toilet paper, linen
- **Pantry Essentials – A full belly means hope:**
Mielie meal, samp, beans, rice, sugar, oil, tinned food, vegetables, spices, tea, fresh milk, coffee
- **Kitchen Needs – Feed more, serve better:**
Hard Deep Freeze - 590 litres, Double door large fridge - 720 litres (Dimensions: 1140 x 630 x 2010), Plastic cutlery, Hair nets, Aprons
- **Bathrooms – Refresh, renew, restore:**
8x Shower Curtains (Industrial), Towels, wash cloths
- **Additional needs!**
Heavy duty black bags, soccer kit (11 pairs of soccer boots, 11 soccer jersey 11 soccer shorts, 11 shin pads, Double door large fridge (NOT the standard household fridge), Deep Freeze
- **First Aid Kit Items – Because safety and care come first:**
Panado, plasters, disposable surgical gloves, antiseptic cream, scissors, gauze bandages, digital thermometer, cotton swabs/balls or pads, alcohol-based hand sanitizer, safety pins and roller bandages
- **Project Needs**
Painting interior of office building, installating blinds in the boardroom, installing office air conditioners, polish wooden floors.
Pantry floor and shelving renovation. Need to take out wooden shelves and re-do floor as cement floor. Need to have stainless steel pantry shelving installed.
- **Activities – tools to change lives!**
Preparing and donating shelter lunch/ supper for shelter beneficiaries
- **Occupational health and safety**

 - **Non-Slippery Mats**
